Dear Tire Retailers:

RE: New Scrap Tire Collection Contracts and Collection Zone Adjustments

Existing contracts issued by TSS for the provision of scrap tire collection services to Saskatchewan retailers expire at the end of December 2022. TSS recently completed a Request for Proposals (RFP) for all 6 collection zones (see map for Zone boundaries) to provide services for the next two years. This process ensures our remittance fees charged to consumers remain as low as possible.

I am pleased to advise that the following collection contractors will be serving tire retailers and TSS for the next two years under contracts that begin January 1, 2023. The designated collector for each zone is as follows:

While we are not expecting any disruption in services, TSS will work with retailers and all collectors to make the transition as seamless as possible as Zones 3, 5 and 6 will have new collectors. Beginning January please feel free to contact your designated collector directly provided your account is current, or the TSS office, with any service concerns or special needs.

TSS is pleased with the tendering process for our collection services as the process does allow us to operate an efficient and effective program, keep fees low to consumers, and service levels high with retailers. Last year TSS conducted a similar process for a second processor for the southern portion of the province. Some adjustments to Zones have been made effective January 1, 2023, to allow for optimal hauling costs for when this occurs. Some retailers may be in a different Zone as a result.
